Course Description: Topics for the Criminal Elements of the Sovereign Citizen Movement Workshop address the beliefs of sovereign citizens and the threats that the criminal extremist element of the movement present to law enforcement officers. Extensive coverage will be afforded to indicators that enable law enforcement officers to recognize sovereign citizens and assess the level of threat. Various frauds employed by sovereign citizens will also be discussed.

Train-the-Trainer Workshop topics include international and domestic terrorism and terrorism indicators. While emphasis is placed on assisting agencies in developing in-house anti-terrorism training capabilities, trainers and nontrainers will benefit from this course.
