



## PATROL RIFLE COURSE

**The Hoonah Department of Public Safety** is hosting a Patrol Rifle course, certified by the Alaska Police Standards Council, in Hoonah, Alaska

**July 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015**

Class will run from 0800 hours to approximately 1700 hours each day. This course is taught in accordance with the Alaska Department of Public Safety Patrol Rifle manual. **Scores of 80% or greater on a written test and qualification course of fire are required for certification.**

### **Equipment Requirements:**

Semi-automatic magazine-fed rifle suitable for police use (AR-15 platform is the most common) and at least three reliable magazines (20 round or greater capacity)  
Rifle ammunition (approximately 800 rounds)  
Handgun and ammunition (100 rounds)  
Rifle/Handgun care and cleaning supplies  
Duty belt with secure holster  
Body armor  
Eye and ear protection, ball cap, foul weather gear  
Hand-held flashlight

### **Optional:**

Supplemental armor (plate carrier with rifle plates)  
Chest rig or other ammunition support system  
Ballistic helmet  
Shooting gloves  
Knee & elbow pads  
Hydration equipment  
Rifle Optic (Holographic, Red Dot, or Magnified)  
Weapon-mounted flashlight  
Electronic (amplified) hearing protection
