

The Department of Public Safety Training Academy is hosting a basic patrol rifle course, sponsored by the Alaska Police Standards Council, the Department of Public Safety Training Academy & the Alaska State Troopers

November 14th — 16th, 2016

Located at the Department of Public Safety Training Academy in Sitka, AK

Class will run from approximately 0800-1700 hours each day. This course is taught in accordance with the Department of Public Safety Training Academy patrol rifle manual. Due to the generous support from APSC, the cost for the room, meals, ammunition, and all training materials is covered. Transportation will be provided from the airport to the DPS Academy but departments will be responsible for transportation to Sitka. There is no need to rent a vehicle.

Equipment Requirements:

- Semi-automatic magazine-fed rifle suitable for police use with iron sights. (AR-15 platform is most common) and at least three reliable magazines (20 round or greater capacity). The DPS Training Academy will have a limited supply of patrol rifles available on a first come, first served basis for student training.
- Duty belt, with duty sidearm
- Ballistic vest
- Eye and ear protection, ball cap, and foul weather gear.
- Hand-held flashlight
- Warm weather gear
- Police range uniform/ BDUs

Optional:

- Supplemental armor (plate carrier with rifle plates)
- Chest rig or other ammunition support system
- Shooting gloves, knee & elbow pads
- Rifle optic, weapon-mounted flashlight
