

13 AAC 02.020(a)(2) is amended to read:

(2) **circular** flashing yellow (caution signal) – when a yellow **circular** lens is lighted with rapid intermittent flashes, drivers of vehicles may proceed cautiously through the intersection or past the yellow signal. **Drivers must yield the right-of-way to other vehicles lawfully within the intersections, other vehicles approaching on another roadway so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard, and to pedestrians lawfully within the intersection or an adjacent crosswalk at the time the signal is exhibited;**

13 AAC 02.020(a) is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(3) flashing yellow arrow (yield turn signal) - when a yellow arrow lens is lighted with rapid intermittent flashes, drivers of vehicles may proceed cautiously through the intersection to make the movement indicated by the arrow. Drivers must yield the right-of-way to other vehicles lawfully within the intersection, other vehicles approaching on another roadway so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard, and to pedestrians lawfully within the intersection or an adjacent crosswalk at the time the signal is exhibited.
