More Identifying Information on Warrant List

(ANCHORAGE, Alaska) – The Alaska State Trooper warrants posted on the Department of Public Safety website will now include a gender code. The update will take place on July 9, 2009.

The Warrant list currently identifies an individual only by name (first and last name, and in most cases includes a middle name or initial) and age. Adding a gender code will further clarify whom troopers are actually seeking.

The Alaska State Troopers request the public's assistance in providing information on the location of the individuals listed on the site. If you have information on the whereabouts of an individual listed, please contact the nearest law enforcement agency.

The list contains active warrants issued by the Alaska State Court System in relation to AST cases. The Alaska State Troopers request that no citizen take action in these matters beyond contacting their local law enforcement agency. **DO NOT TAKE THE LAW INTO YOUR OWN HANDS BY ATTEMPTING TO APPREHEND OR DETAIN THESE INDIVIDUALS.** All warrants must be confirmed in the Alaska Public Safety Information Network before arrests are made.
