Change of Plea Closes Whittier Homicide Case

(ANCHORAGE, Alaska) – Shaka Levshakoff pled guilty in Anchorage Superior Court today on charges relating to the beating death of two-year-old Anne Marie Nimmo of Whittier, Alaska. Nimmo was pronounced deceased on June 24, 2007 at the Whittier Clinic after Nimmo's mother and a clinic assistant brought her there for treatment.

Levshakoff pled guilty to Manslaughter and Interference to Official Proceedings. Levshakoff was sentenced to 20 years in prison with five years suspended and 10 years probation following his release from prison for the Manslaughter charge. He received three years with two years suspended in relation to the Interference to Official Proceeding charge. The sentences are to be served consecutively.
