Attendees will use ultraviolet, visible, and infrared light to reveal hidden traces and learn proper photographic and digital documentation methods. Practical exercises include recovering footwear impressions, lifting latent fingerprints from challenging surfaces using a variety of methods. The course also covers detecting biological fluids, gunpowder patterns, and other trace evidence using alternate light sources and filters. Participants will leave with proven methods to effectively locate and preserve critical forensic evidence.
