After a few attempts the Datamaster was able to operate properly and the problem fixed itself. I contacted the crime lab and requested new external standards, which were later installed. Crime lab personnel downloaded the data and could not see a problem with the instrument readings and also recommended changing the external standard. No other action was taken and the Datamaster has had no repeated similar issues.
