

DENIAL OF APPLICATION FOR POLICE OFFICER CERTIFICATION

Jack W. Wray, Director of the Alaska Police Standards Council, Department of Public Safety of the State of Alaska, under the authority of AS 18.65.220(5), denies the application of John J. Williams for certification as a police officer pursuant to AS 18.65.220(2), AS 18.65.240(a)(2), AS 18.65.240(c), AS 18.65.270, AS 44.62.330 et seq., 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), 13 AAC 85.040(b)(2), 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3).

The Director finds that:

- On or about January 1, 1991, the applicant was hired as a police officer by the St. Mary's Police Department.
- 2. On or about April 1, 1991, the Alaska Police Standards Council (APSC) received a completed, signed and notarized Personal History Statement (APSC Form F-3).
- 3. In the Personal History Statement received on April 1, 1991, the applicant responded to the question "Have you ever been arrested or detained by a law enforcement agency" by stating "Jan. 1981 Misdemeanor Lewd conduct S. Orange County Municipal Court."

4. On or about December 9, 1991, the APSC received an Application for Certification endorsed by the applicant and approved by Chief of Police Stanley Higgins.

- 5. On or about December 10, 1991, APSC received an FBI Identification record which substantiated the applicant's arrest on January 8, 1981, and conviction on June 1, 1981, for disorderly conduct/solicit lewd act.
- 6. On or about December 20, 1991, APSC received copies of investigation reports relating to the applicant's arrest by the Orange County Sheriff's Department, Santa Ana, California.
- 7. On or about February 26, 1992, a review committee of APSC council members reviewed the reports prepared by the Orange County Sheriff's Department, the FBI Identification Record, the the applicant's Personal History Statement and they agreed that applicant did not meet the minimum standards for moral character established for police officers in Alaska.

The Director has determined that:

8. Based on the above findings there are adequate grounds to deny the application because of the applicant's failure to meet the minimum standards for moral character. This determination constitutes a sufficient basis to deny the application.

WHEREFORE, the Director denies police officer certification to John J. Williams.
