Subject: King Cove PD DataMaster DMT 100666 Data Retrieval

On 01/12/2024 all testing data was pulled from long-term memory from DataMaster DMT 100666. This includes all file types. This data was transferred and imported into the DMHost Database utilized by the Breath Test Program. The data before and after this long-term retrieval was compared against each other.

Background

DataMaster DMT 100666 was placed in service at King Cove PD on 04/27/2020 (100666 2020.04.27 Change In Status) and was removed from service on 12/28/2023 (100666 2023.12.28 Change In Status) for data file evaluation. The instrument was functional when it was removed from service.

Upon arrival at the Crime Lab, the instrument successfully uploaded. This demonstrates the functionality of the modem board. The instrument also successfully uploaded during the certification in 2020 (100666 2020.03.23 Cert). This instrument was returned from the field after approximately 3.5 years of unsuccessful uploading while in the field at King Cove. While in the field, datafiles were manually retrieved from the instrument using a USB drive and sent to the crime lab, this is usually requested by the crime lab on VOC days. During a recent In Field Instrument Review cycle, it was discovered that there were missing VOC datafiles, prompting the return of the instrument.

Test data for the instrument was printed from the DMHost Database for the period that the instrument was in service at King Cove, between 04/27/2020 - 12/28/2023. The instrument was uploaded during Check In, where there were 0 files available for transfer on the short-term memory. Test data was printed two times. First, after the instrument was successfully uploaded via modern line while at the Crime Lab, demonstrating no new files were present. And second, after all files were pulled from the instrument's long-term memory and transferred to the database. These records were compared for completeness.

It was found to have the following missing files: 1 tank change record (04/27/2020), 4 breath test records (06/27/2020, 06/27/2020, 07/02/2020, and 06/03/2021), and 4 Verification of Calibration (VOC) records (04/27/2020, 09/05/2023, 09/26/2023, and 11/27/2023).
