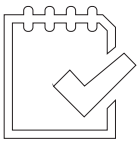

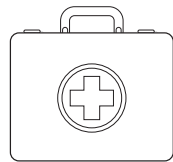

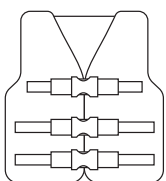
Create an emergency plan.

and when you will return.



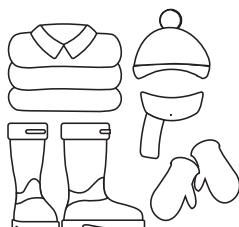
Have a VHF radio
