### Good afternoon Trooper Massey,

We're going to send you a replacement Datamaster for St. Mary's. The cause of these standard out of range status messages is most likely instrumental and not due to the new tank.

Also, the DMT has a sample chamber temperature working tolerance that prevents it from running a test if the chamber gets too hot or too cold. This tolerance is 48C +/- 4C. Any allowable temperature variations are too small to cause a change in the measured ethanol concentration. Changing the room temperature did not cause the last VOC to pass. If you have any questions, feel free to give me a call.

St Mary's VOC failed 3 times, then passed the fourth. The new external standard is out of range (.086 with a target of .080, at 30.02 inches) and should be replaced. It passed because I increased the Datamaster room temperature, resulting in a sample chamber temperature increase of 1.7 degrees Celsius and the associated external standard density decrease. Is it possible to send a replacement? Thank you.
