#### ACCUSATION

James F. Mayer, Administrator of the Alaska Police Standards Council, Department of Public Safety of the State of Alaska, moves to revoke the certificate of Allan D. Schumacher as a police officer, pursuant to AS 18.65.220(1), AS 18.65.240(a)(2), AS 18.65.240(c), AS 17.65.270, AS 44.62.330 et. seq., 13 AAC 85.100(a)(2) and 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3). The Administrator alleges as follows:

- 1. On or about January 1, 1978, respondent became an employee of the Anchorage Police Department.
- 2. On or about March 22, 1979, respondent submitted an application to the Alaska Police Standards Council for police officer certification.
- 3. On or about April 2, 1979, respondent was certified as a police officer in the State of Alaska.
- 4. On or about May 1, 1981, respondent used official Anchorage Police Department identification to obtain treatment not available to the general public in purchasing airline tickets by personal check in violation of Anchorage Police Department regulation 4.15.00.
- 5. On or about May 9, 1981, respondent issued a personal check to Western Airlines, Anchorage in the amount of \$1,176.88 knowing his account had insufficient funds for reimbursement, in violation of Anchorage Police Department regulation 4.00.00.

6. On or about June 4, 1981, respondent was terminated for cause from employment as a police officer with the Anchorage, Alaska Police Department.

## COUNT I

- 7. Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges:
- 8. The termination of respondent in paragraph 6 constitutes grounds for revocation of respondent's police officer certificate pursuant to 13 AAC 85.100(a)(2).

## COUNT II

- 9. Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges:
- 10. The conduct of respondent set forth in paragraph 5 constitutes grounds for revocation of respondent's police officer certificate pursuant to 13 AAC 85.100(a)(3) and 13 AAC 85.010(a)(4).

# COUNT III

- 11. Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition the Administrator alleges:
- 12. Respondent's certificate as a police officer may be revoked because his conduct as set out in paragraphs 4 and 5 does not meet the

minimum standards for certified police officers under AS 18.65.240(a)(2). WHEREFORE, the Administrator prays that the certificate of Allan D.
