  - (A) fire prevention and suppression;
  - (B) provision of emergency medical services; and
  - (C) participation in and coordination of search and rescue efforts for missing or injured persons;
- (2) providing pretrial, probation, and parole supervision to persons under supervision of pretrial services, probation, and parole officers;
- (3) conducting investigations;
- (4) enforcing
  - (A) the criminal laws of the state or a municipality;
  - (B) statutes or ordinances of the state or municipality punishable as a violation;
- (5) providing local training programs on public safety; and
- (6) the powers usually and customarily exercised by a peace officer.
