Fatal errors happen occasionally and a reboot usually fixes those. I would like to just keep an eye on the instrument and see if there are any other issues. Please let us know as soon as possible if you continue to get unusual status messages or more invalid status messages. We will keep an eye on it as well. Also, I will document this in the instrument file.
