AFFIDAVIT OF JACK W. WRAY

Jack W. Wray, being first duly sworn upon oath, hereby deposes and states that:

- A: I am employed as the Administrator for the Alaska Police Standards Council (hereafter: Council).
- B: As Administrator, my duties include the investigation of allegations and, when appropriate, the filing of accusation which may result in the revocation of police certificates.
- C: I have conducted an investigation into the matter of Jackie C. Sallison. Based upon the results of that investigation, and upon documents and records contained in Council files, it is my information and belief that:
- 1. On or about September 10, 1987, respondent was hired as a police officer for the St. Mary's Police Department.
- 2. On or about October 17, 1988, respondent was discharged for cause from his employment as a police officer for the St. Mary's Police Department.
- 3. On or about December 29, 1988, respondent was reinstated as a police officer for the St. Mary's Police Department.
- 4. On or about January 3, 1989, respondent submitted an application to the Alaska Police Standards Council (APSC) for a police officer certificate.
- 5. On or about January 10, 1989, respondent was certified as a police officer in the State of Alaska.
- 6. On or about February 7, 1989, respondent was discharged for cause from his employment as a police officer for the St. Mary's Police Department.
- 7. On or about February 17, 1989, respondent entered a plea of no contest to the crime of misconduct involving weapons in the second degree in the District Court for the State of Alaska at St. Mary's.

8. On or about February 17, 1989, respondent was found and adjudged guilty of the crime of misconduct involving weapons in the second degree and imposition of sentence was suspended and respondent was placed on probation until February 17, 1990, and ordered to attend AA meetings at least once a week and to report progress to the court once a month, obey all laws, and not to drink or enter where alcohol of any type is being bought or sold.

D: On June 21, 1990, I sent to respondent by U.S. Mail, return receipt requested, documents consisting of an Accusation, Statutes of the Alaska Police Standards Council, Regulations of the Alaska Police Standards Council, the Administrative Procedures Act, and a Notice of Defense. The Accusation contained the allegations shown as numbered paragraphs 1-8 above.

E: On July 30, 1990, a United States Postal Service "Return Receipt," signed with the name "Jackie C. Sallison" and dated July 25, 1990, was received by the Council. A copy of the return receipt is attached to this affidavit.

F: The Notice of Defense sent to the respondent contains instructions that the Notice must be filed with the Council within 15 days of receipt.

G: The 15 day period during which respondent could have filed a Notice of Defense expired on August 9, 1990. As of the date of this Affidavit, no Notice of Defense was ever received from respondent.

H: I conclude that the conduct described in numbered paragraphs 6-8 of the accusation demonstrates that respondent discharged a firearm while under the influence of alcohol, was discharged for cause, from employment as a police officer in the State of Alaska and lacks good moral character. Respondent therefore does not meet the minimum standards for a certified police officer established under AS 18.65.240(a)(2), 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), and 13 AAC 85.110(a)(2) and (3) and his police officer certificate must be revoked.

Further your affiant sayeth naught.

Respondent therefore does not meet the minimum standards for a certified police officer established under AS 18.65.240(a)(2), 13 AAC 85.010(a)(3), and 13 AAC 85.110(a)(3), and his police officer certificate should be revoked.

Count II

10. Paragraphs 1 through 8 are incorporated by reference as though set forth in detail. In addition, the Administrator alleges that respondent was discharged, for cause, from employment as a police officer in Alaska, and therefore, his police officer certificate should be revoked under AS 18.65.240(a)(2) and 13 AAC 85.110(a)(2).

Wherefore, the Administrator prays that Jackie C. Sallison's certificate as a police officer in the State of Alaska be revoked.
